EQUIPMENT POLICY

- A. All coaches shall make attempts to ensure that every player taking part in any game or practice is dressed in the proper equipment as stated by Hockey Alberta and WMHA. The following applies with regard to WMHA equipment and uniforms.
 - a. Uniforms and WMHA equipment will not be used for non-team functions.
 - b. Names bar and captain letters are not to be pressed onto a hockey jersey. Captain letters are hand stitched only. Name bars are to be attached and removed by a professional company. If pressed on, the parent is responsible for the cost of a new jersey.
 - c. Equipment belonging to WMHA will be placed in the care and custody of the coach at the beginning of the hockey season. The person signing for the equipment shall be held responsible for this equipment and will be asked to account for it at the end of the season.
 - d. Any goalie equipment provided by WMHA shall only be used for sanctioned events. Exceptions may be granted by the WMHA
 - e. Jersey's and socks supplied by WMHA are to be used for games only (not practices). Usage for any other events must be approved by the Executive.
 - f. Parents or guardians are responsible to sign for WMHA team equipment. A commitment bond is required and if a jersey is damaged beyond regular wear and tear, a charge of \$150 will be applied to your TeamSnap account. Lack of payment may result in suspension until the fees are paid in full.
 - g. When equipment supplied by WMHA is lost or damaged, the person who signed for it MUST report the incident to the equipment manager immediately.
 - h. WMHA equipment may only be purchased on the direction of the executive.

- Goalie pads, chest protector, blocker and trapper will be supplied to all goalies up to the U11 level if needed.
- j. Each goalie is allowed to submit receipts for reimbursement up to \$250 for equipment including goalie sticks purchased during the current season. Cut off for reimbursement will be May 15.
