FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENT



Association Commitment

Every player in WMHA must commit to the following fundraising requirements:

- A. Help volunteer and host a home tournament.
 - a. A minimum of \$75 is required to be put towards the tournament per player. This can be monetary or donations. It can be put towards any aspect of the tournament; prize table, award, or other.
 - b. A commitment to work assigned shifts during the tournament.
 - c. The U18 level is not obligated to host a tournament. As a result, the U18 level will not receive team funds from WMHA. If the U18 level chooses to host a tournament, the above points apply (A-a and A-b).

AND

B. Partake in the association fundraisers and commit to selling monetary value of \$150 total in online ticket sales, raffle tickets or other fundraisers presented by WMHA including but not limited to a Casino, battery drive or other event.

Failure to reach fundraising requirement

- A. Fundraising requirements must be met by February 1, of the current hockey season.
- B. Failure to do so will result in your teamsnap account being charged \$150.
- C. Failure to volunteer during your home tournament will result in your teamsnap account being charged \$200.

Please note, this is per player NOT per family.

Team Fundraising Guidelines

- A. Teams wishing to fundraise must have the fundraisers approved by the WMHA Board.
- B. Fundraising money must be used for team associated expenses such as: apparel, extra ice, tournament fees, player development, team based events, snacks for games, or other approved expenses.
